Patient Portal services (315.e.1)	Patient portal services allow patients access to view their health information online as well as to download and transmit a summary of their healthcare information to third parties electronically.	The certified product-version may require ongoing monthly costs to support online patient portal services. Ongoing monthly costs are charged as a flat rate per provider.	The only contractual limitation is that all providers at the practice must subscribe to online patient portal services, such as EMR Direct.	No technical or practical limitations.
Non-Patient Portal Services	The certified product-version only contains patient portal services and is designed to work with a certified EMR to handle non-patient portal services.	The certified product-version only contains patient portal services and may require one-time costs to establish interfaces to a certified EMR. The one-time cost is charged at the practice level per interface.	There are no contractual limitations.	There may be technical or practical limitations depending upon the type of interface or the hardware hosting the interface. The speed of the hardware and internet access for either the practice or registry could physically limit the speed and number of records that can be sent.
